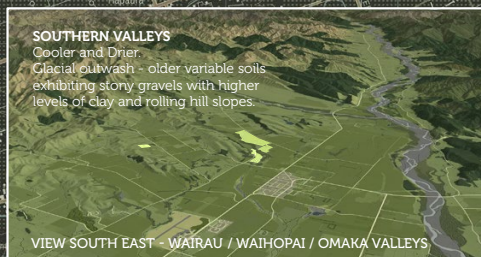

alluvium seams.

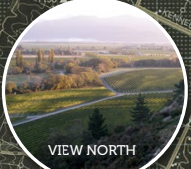
